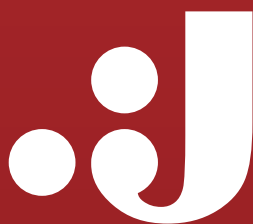

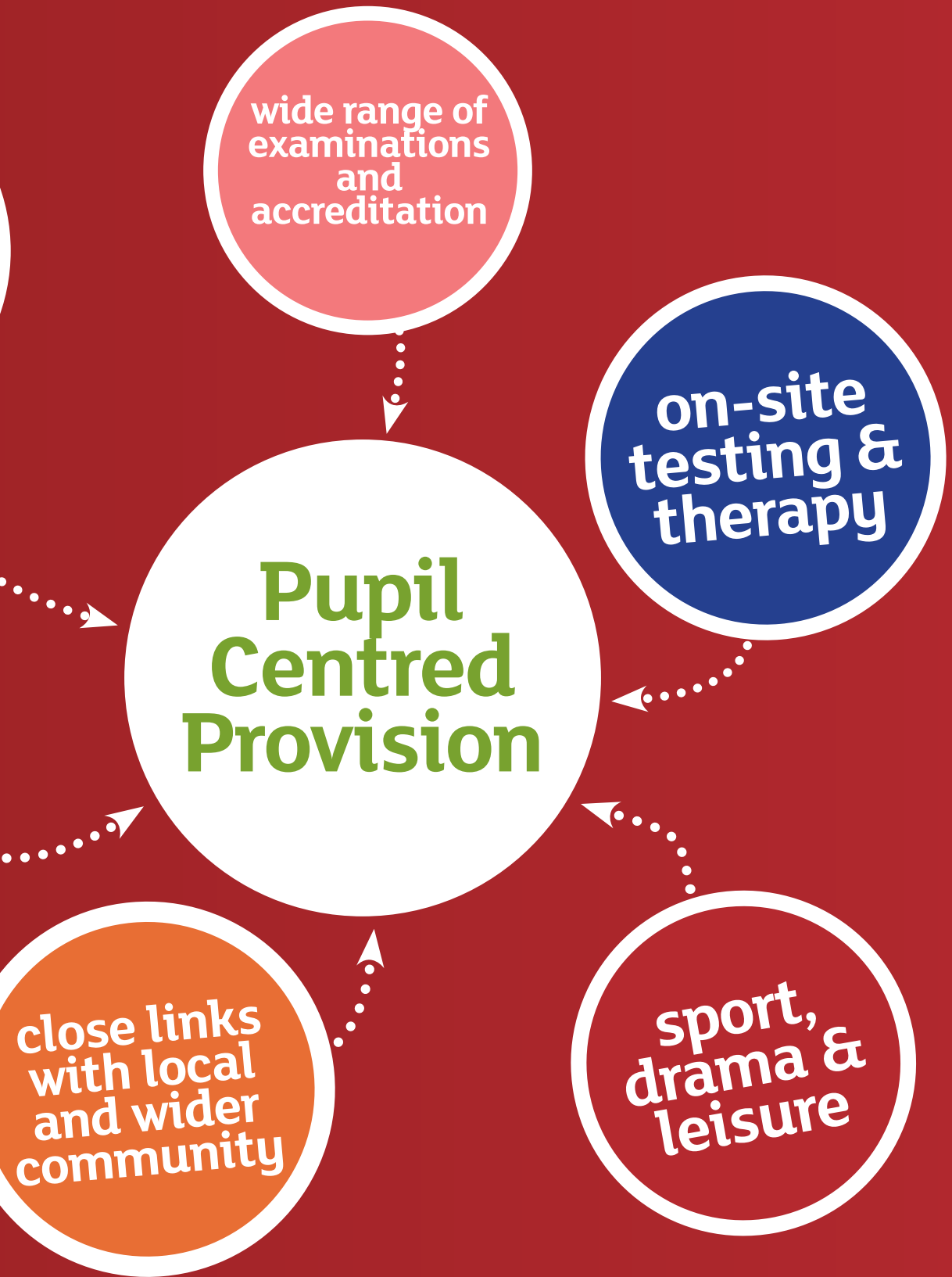

Every child has different needs. Needs that, when not met, can sometimes act as a barrier to concentration, achievement and happiness. At Jordanstown, we specialise in meeting the specific needs of children who are deaf or have visual impairments. By doing 'what works best for every child,' using a combination of the latest technologies and experienced, attentive teaching, we offer an individual approach to communication that is tailored to maximise the learning potential of every single child. All our permanent members of teaching staff are specifically trained and qualified in teaching pupils who are deaf and/or have a visual impairment.

All our staff team use Total Communication, Sign Supported English, BSL, FM and Soundfield Systems, Moon, Braille, closed circuit electronic magnification tools and large print formats to engage and educate both in and outside of the classroom.

We appreciate the most effective learning and teaching takes place when parents and all relevant professionals liaise closely with school. We actively encourage and foster close links between parents, school staff, our Board of Trustees and Governors, therapists, other health care professionals and external partners linked to our pupils.





In addition to being a specialist learning environment, Jordanstown is also equipped with the latest testing and therapy facilities. Used by medical professionals from local Health and Social Care Trusts, it offers children and their parents a simpler, easier and more comfortable way to access medical and therapy input, reducing unnecessary time spent away from the classroom. These facilities include a hydrotherapy pool, therapy rooms and training rooms.
